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

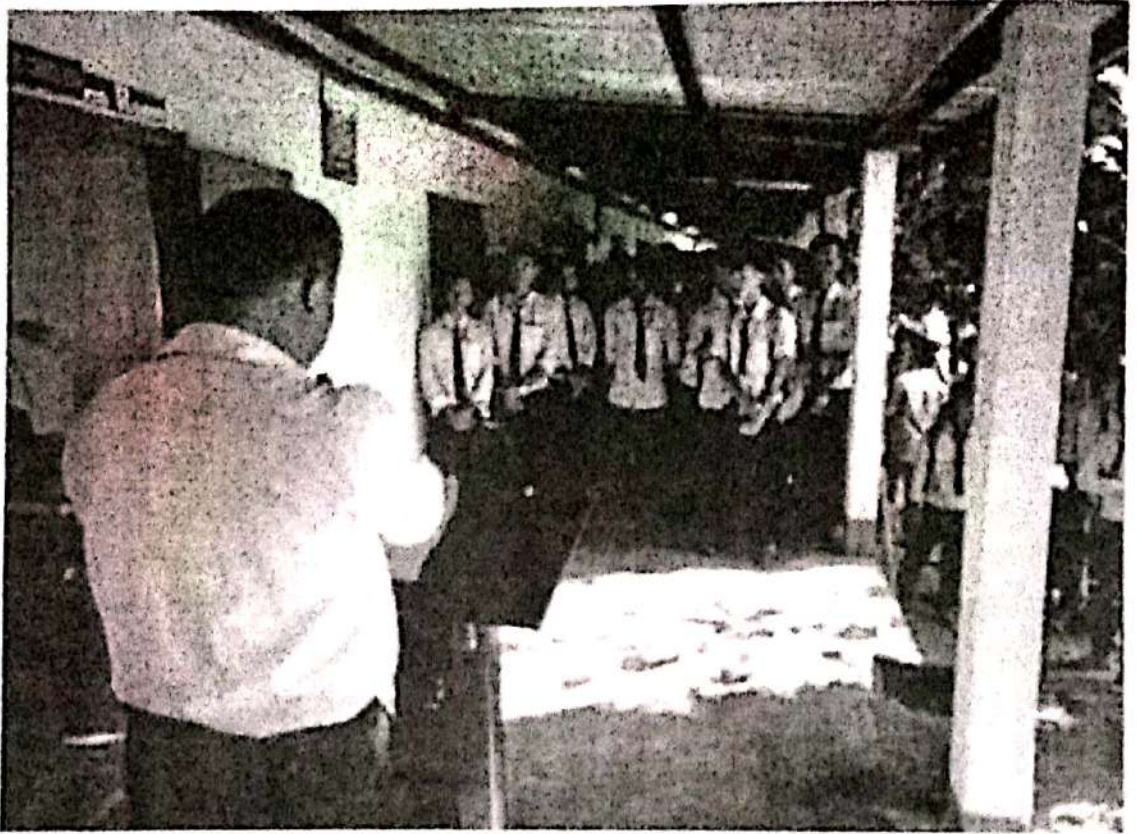
Two Days Book Fair

Sessional Examination: 2016

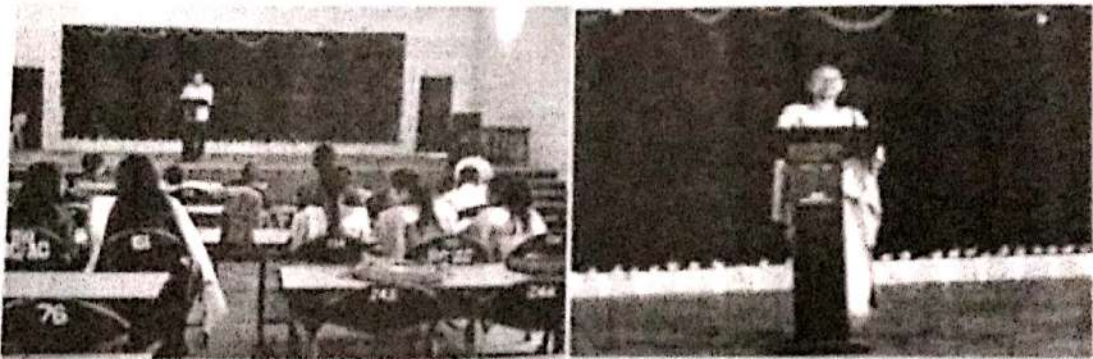
The Sessional Examination, 2016 for TDC 1st, 3rd and 6th semester commenced from 20th October to 27th October 2016.

Participation in Football Match

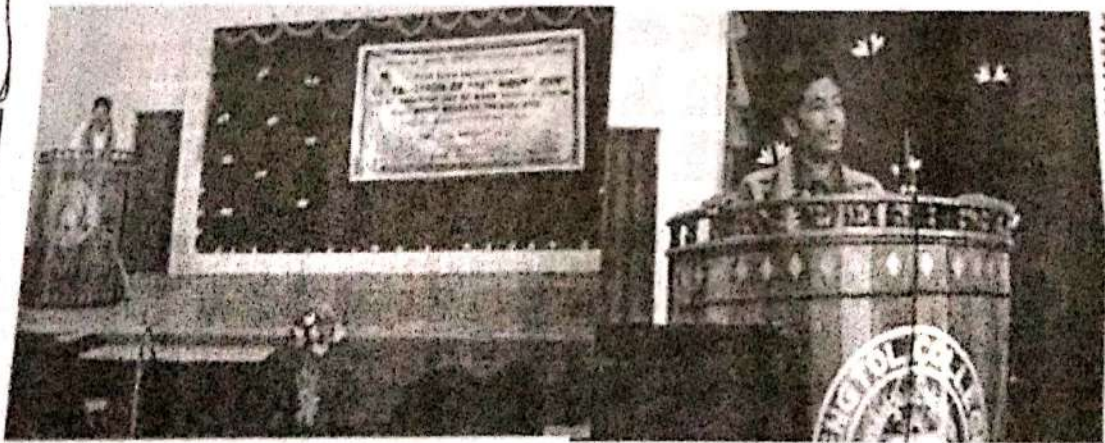

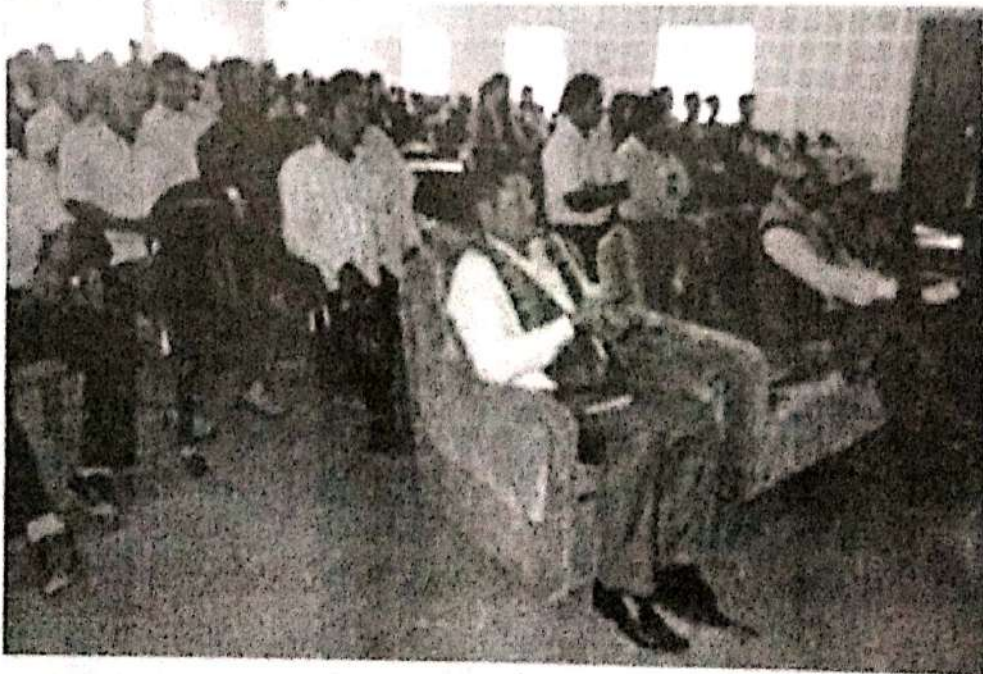




Some views of training on Bio-organic fertilizer production and Mushroom cultivation.

30th November 2016: Bengtol College Students celebrated Pre Christmas

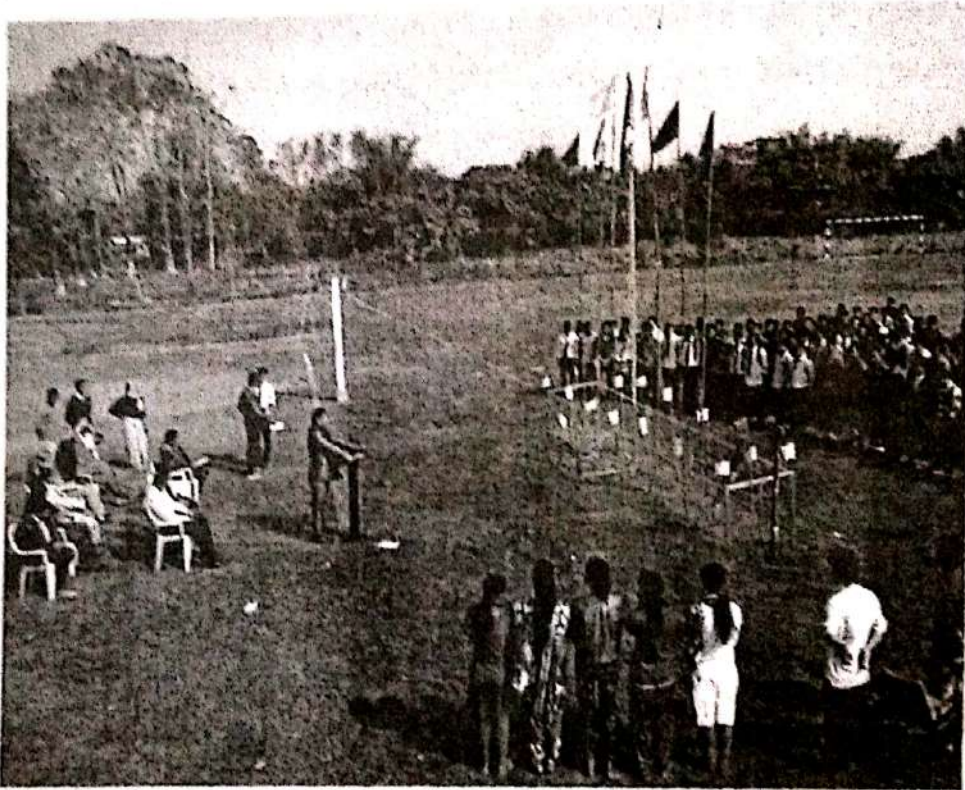

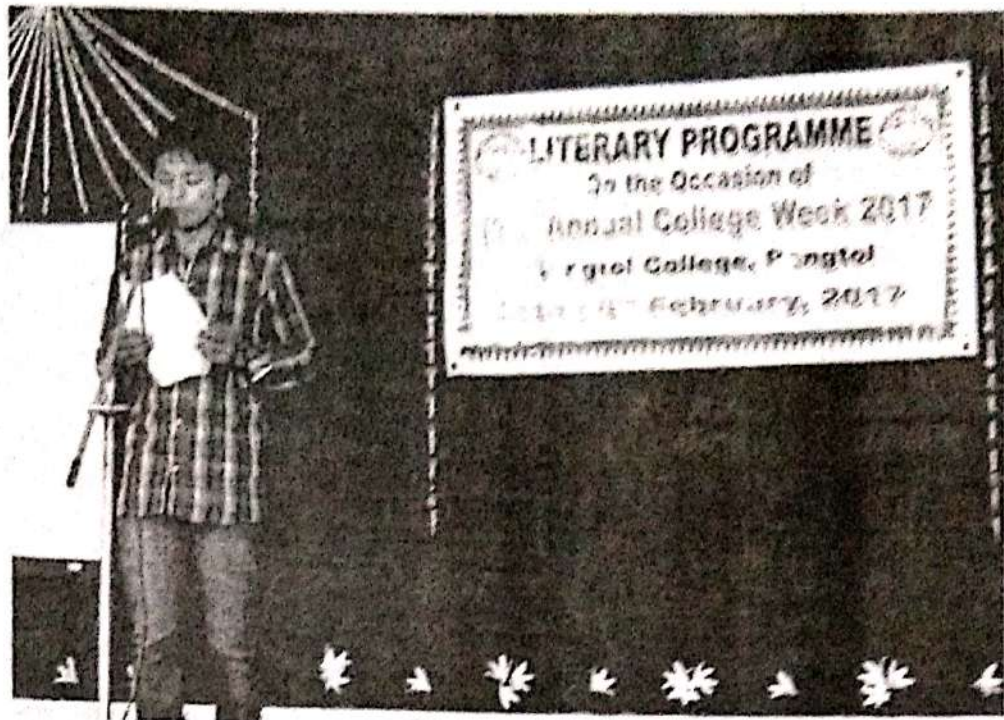
The 17th College Week:
