Report on Seminar/Workshop organized from 2017 to 2022

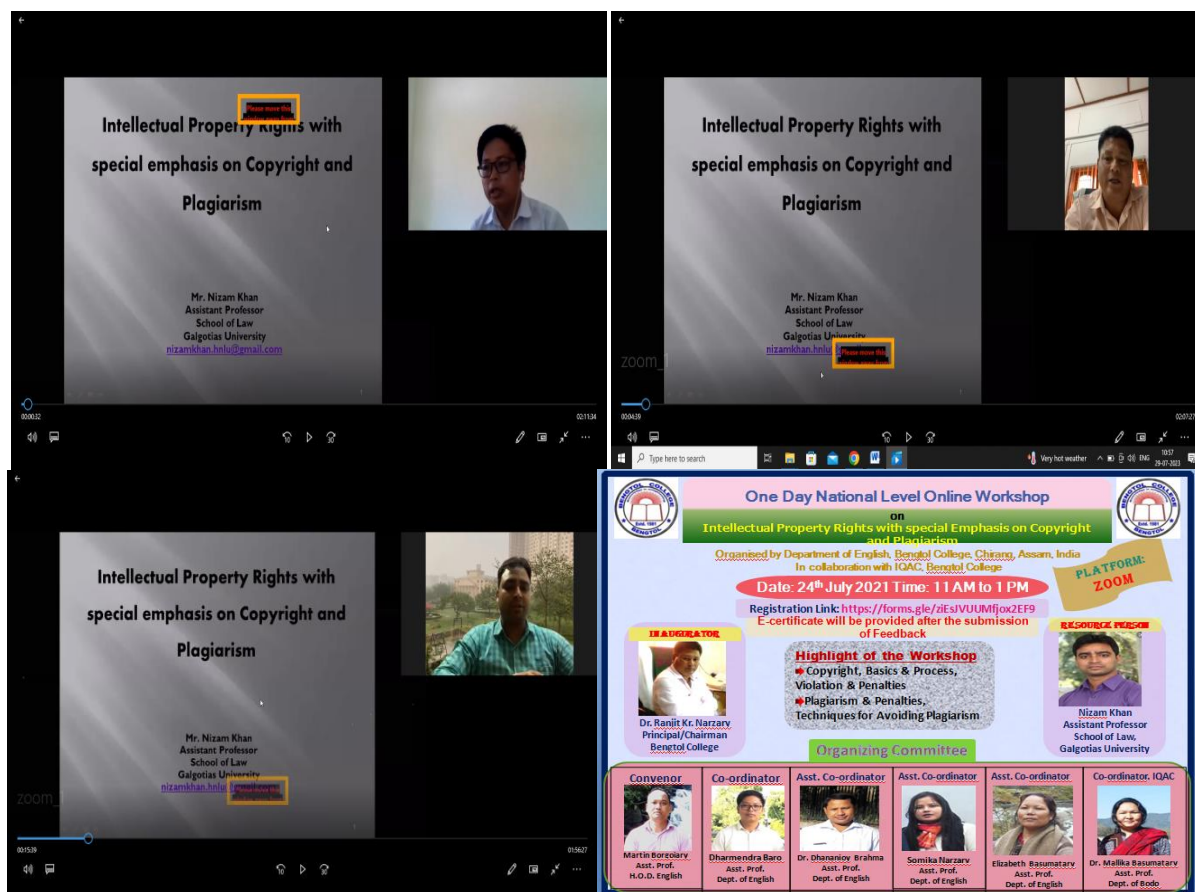
14 & 15th November 2019:

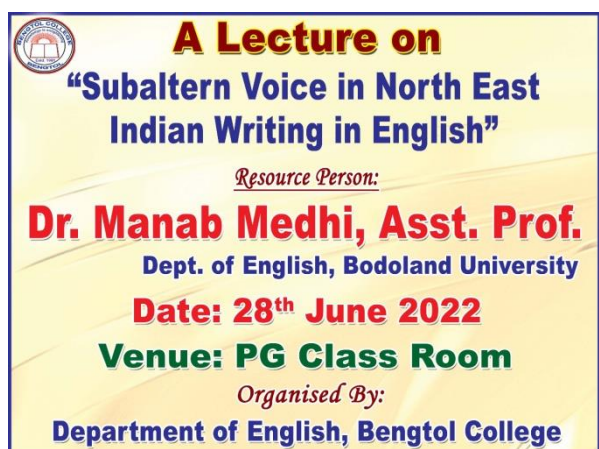
24th July 2021:

28th June 2022:

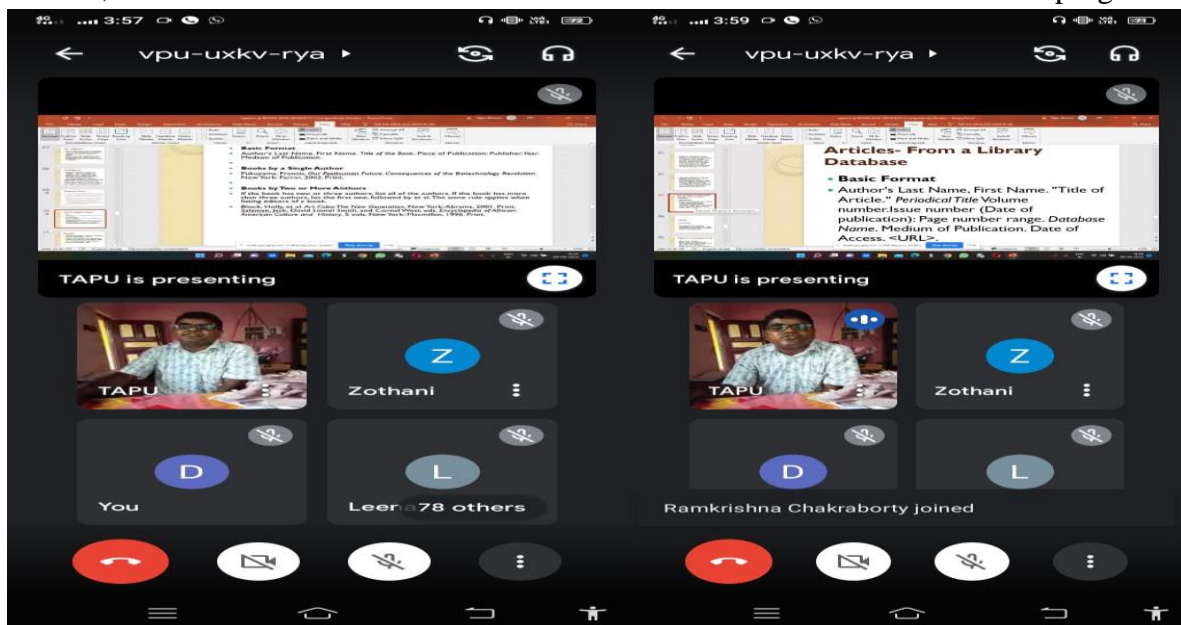

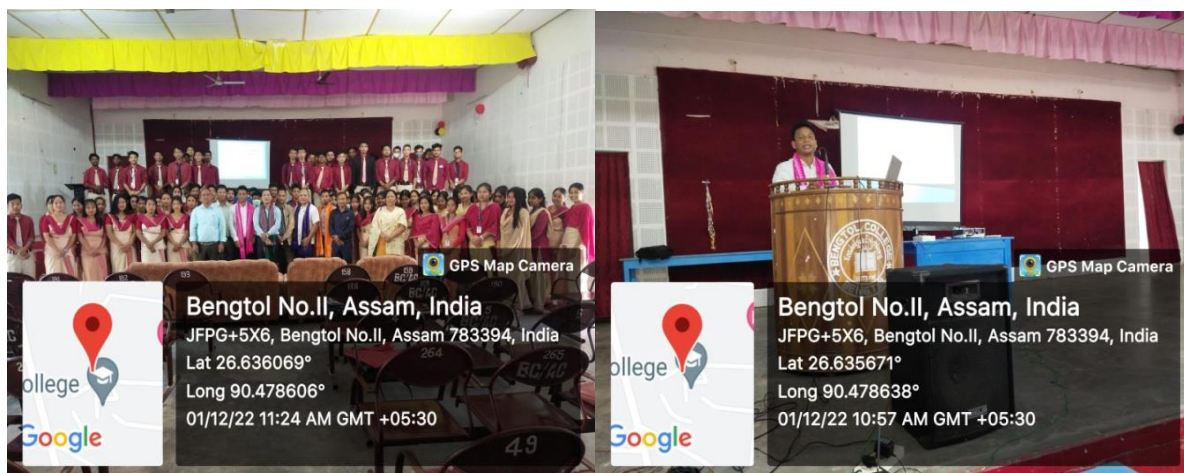
9th August 2022:

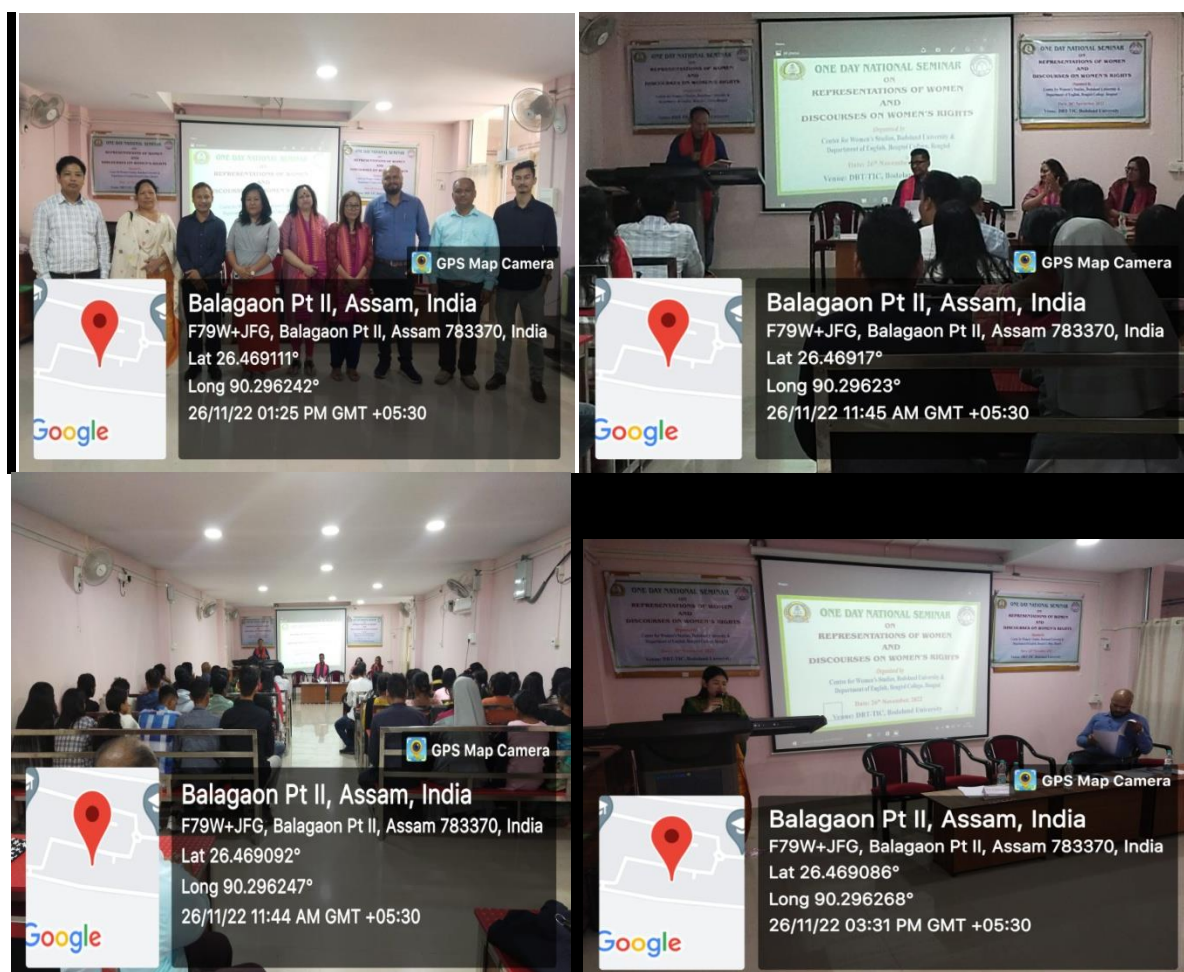
1st December 2022:
