Despite our sincere efforts, this newsletter might contain some unnoticed errors. Any suggestions for rectifications and improvement will be considered with due acknowledgement.

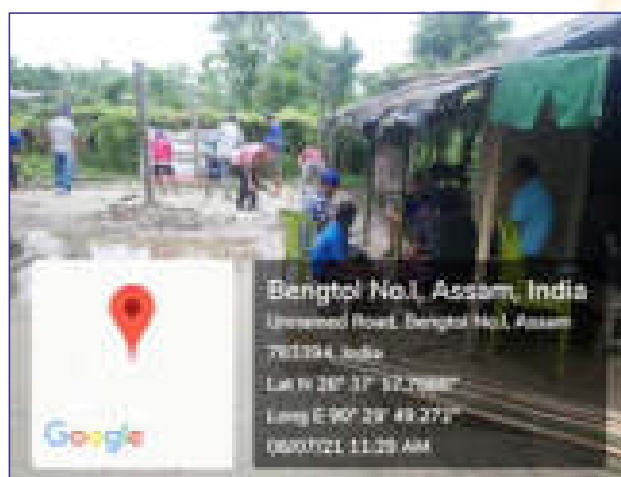
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House Construction by NSS Unit: 8th July 2021

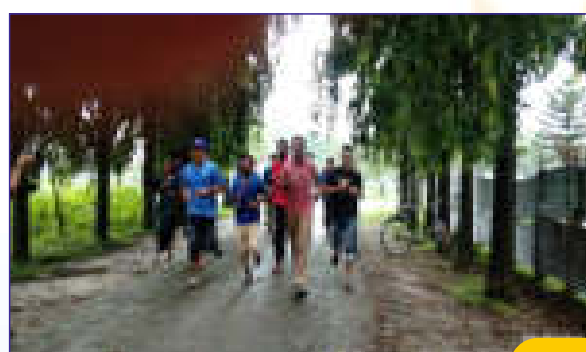
Participation of NSS Voluteers in Cheer up for India for Tokyo Olympics 2021 Programme : 25th July
