
FEP : Deptt. of Education



NSS Special Camp


Self-defense training for girls

Computer Training Programme for Teachers



The Department of Bodo, Bengtol College organized two day seminar for the post-graduate students of the Department on 15th & 16th March 2022.




Felicitation programme organized by Alumni Association
